

Turnkey Privacy Notice

Last Updated: March 15, 2023

This Privacy Notice is designed to help you understand how Turnkey Global, Inc. (“**Turnkey**,” “**we**,” “**us**,” or “**our**”) collects, uses, processes, and shares your personal information, and to help you understand and exercise your privacy rights.

1. SCOPE AND UPDATES TO THIS PRIVACY NOTICE

This Privacy Notice applies to personal information processed by us when providing our non-custodial key management solution, including on our websites, and other online or offline offerings (the “**Turnkey Services**”).

Changes to our Privacy Notice. We may revise this Privacy Notice from time to time in our sole discretion. If there are any material changes to this Privacy Notice, we will notify you as required by applicable law. You understand and agree that you will be deemed to have accepted the updated Privacy Notice if you continue to use our Turnkey Services after the new Privacy Notice takes effect.

2. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

The categories of personal information we collect depend on how you interact with us, our Turnkey Services, and the requirements of applicable law. We collect information that you provide to us, information we obtain automatically when you use our Turnkey Services, and information from other sources such as third-party services and organizations, as described below.

A. Personal Information You Provide to Us Directly

We may collect personal information that you provide to us.

- **Account Creation.** We may collect personal information when you create an account, such as wallet address, name, and account name.
- **Protocol Payloads, Wallet and other Output Information.** In order to utilize some of the Turnkey Services, you may need to provide us with information about your wallet including the types and amounts of digital assets on the blockchain you possess and details about Protocol payloads into which you have entered. We will never ask you for or collect your private keys.
- **Your Communications with Us.** We may collect personal information, such as names and email address, when you request information about our Turnkey Services, register for our newsletter, request customer or technical support, or otherwise communicate with us.
- **Interactive Features.** We and others who use our Turnkey Services may collect personal information that you directly submit to us through our interactive features.

B. Personal Information Collected Automatically

We may collect personal information automatically when you use our Turnkey Services.

- **Automatic Collection of Personal Information.** We may collect certain information automatically when you use our Turnkey Services, such as your Internet protocol (IP)

address, user settings, MAC address, browser or device information, location information (including approximate location derived from IP address, and Internet service provider. We may also automatically collect information regarding your use of our Turnkey Services, such as pages that you visit before, during and after using our Turnkey Services, information about the links you click, the types of content you interact with, the frequency and duration of your activities, and other information about how you use our Turnkey Services.

- o **Crash Reports.** If you provide crash reports, we may collect personal information related to such crash reports, including detailed diagnostic information about your device and the activities that led to the crash.
- **Analytics.** We may use Technologies and other third-party tools to process analytics information on the Turnkey Services. These Technologies allow us to better understand how our digital Turnkey Services are used and to continually improve and personalize the Turnkey Services. Some of our analytics partners include:

C. Personal Information Collected from Other Sources

Blockchain Networks. We may independently collect personal information from blockchain networks that we have access to. This personal information may include public wallet addresses and details about transactions carried out on the applicable blockchain network.

3. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use your personal information for a variety of business purposes, including to provide our Turnkey Services, for administrative purposes, and to market our products and Turnkey Services, as described below.

A. Provide Our Turnkey Services

We use your information to fulfill our contract with you and provide you with our Turnkey Services, such as:

- Provide, maintain and improve our Turnkey Services;
- Provide and deliver the products and services you request, process transactions and send you related information, including confirmations and receipts,
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts and support and administrative messages;
- Respond to your comments, questions and requests and provide customer service;
- Communicate with you about products and services offered by Turnkey, and provide news and information we think will be of interest to you;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage and activities in connection with our Turnkey Services;
- Detect, investigate and prevent fraudulent transactions and other illegal activities and protect the rights and property of Turnkey and others;
- Personalize and improve the Turnkey Services and provide content or features that match user profiles or interests;
- Link or combine with information we get from others to help understand your needs and provide you with better service; and

- Carry out any other purpose for which the information was collected.

B. Marketing our Products and Turnkey Services

We may use personal information to tailor and provide you with content via email campaigns. We may provide you with these materials as permitted by applicable law.

C. With Your Consent

We may use personal information for other purposes that are clearly disclosed to you at the time you provide personal information or with your consent.

D. Other Purposes

We also use your personal information for other purposes as requested by you or as permitted by applicable law.

- **De-identified and Aggregated Information.** We may use personal information to create de-identified and/or aggregated information, such as demographic information, information about the device from which you access our Turnkey Services, or other analyses we create.

4. HOW WE DISCLOSE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We disclose your personal information to third parties for a variety of business purposes, including to provide our Turnkey Services, to protect us or others, or in the event of a major business transaction such as a merger, sale, or asset transfer, as described below.

A. Disclosures to Provide our Turnkey Services

The categories of third parties with whom we may share your personal information are described below.

- **Notice Regarding Use of Blockchain Networks.** Information about transactions you enter into via the Turnkey Services will be recorded on the blockchain and may be accessible to third parties due to the public nature of the blockchain. Because entries to the blockchain are, by their nature, public, and because it may be possible for someone to identify you through your pseudonymous, public wallet address using external sources of information, any transaction you enter onto the blockchain could possibly be used to identify you, or information about you.
- **Service Providers.** We may share your personal information with our third-party service providers and vendors that assist us with the provision of our Turnkey Services. This includes service providers and vendors that provide us with IT support, third party Protocol participants, services that provide compliance risk assessments, hosting, payment processing, customer service, and related services.
- **Third-Party Services You Share or Interact With.** Certain features and functionalities of the Turnkey Services may link to or allow you to interface, interact, or share information with, access and/or use third-party websites, services, products, and technology (collectively,

“**Third-Party Services**”). Any information shared with or otherwise collected by a Third-Party Service may be subject to the Third-Party Service’s privacy policy. We are not responsible for the processing of personal information by Third-Party Services.

- **Business Partners.** We may share your personal information with business partners to provide you with a product or service you have requested. We may also share your personal information with business partners with whom we jointly offer products or services.
- **Affiliates.** We may share your personal information with our company affiliates.

B. Disclosures to Protect Us or Others

We may access, preserve, and disclose any information we store associated with you to external parties if we, in good faith, believe doing so is required or appropriate to: comply with law enforcement or national security requests and legal process, such as a court order or subpoena; protect your, our, or others’ rights, property, or safety; enforce our policies or contracts; collect amounts owed to us; or assist with an investigation or prosecution of suspected or actual illegal activity.

C. Disclosure in the Event of Merger, Sale, or Other Asset Transfers

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, financing due diligence, reorganization, bankruptcy, receivership, purchase or sale of assets, or transition of service to another provider, your information may be sold or transferred as part of such a transaction, as permitted by law and/or contract.

5. YOUR PRIVACY CHOICES AND RIGHTS

Your Privacy Choices. The privacy choices you may have about your personal information are determined by applicable law and are described below.

- **Email Communications.** If you receive an unwanted email from us, you can use the unsubscribe link found at the bottom of the email to opt out of receiving future emails. Note that you will continue to receive transaction-related emails regarding products or Turnkey Services you have requested. We may also send you certain non-promotional communications regarding us and our Turnkey Services, and you will not be able to opt out of those communications (e.g., communications regarding our Turnkey Services or updates to our Terms or this Privacy Notice).
- **“Do Not Track.”** Do Not Track (“DNT”) is a privacy preference that users can set in certain web browsers. Please note that we do not respond to or honor DNT signals or similar mechanisms transmitted by web browsers.
- **Cookies and Personalized Advertising.** You may stop or restrict the placement of Technologies on your device or remove them by adjusting your preferences as your browser or device permits. However, if you adjust your preferences, the Turnkey Services may not work properly. Please note that cookie-based opt-outs are not effective on mobile applications. However, you may opt-out of personalized advertisements on some mobile applications by following the instructions for [Android](#), [iOS](#), and [others](#).

The online advertising industry also provides websites from which you may opt out of receiving targeted ads from data partners and other advertising partners that participate in self-regulatory programs. You can access these and learn more about targeted advertising

Please note you must separately opt out in each browser and on each device.

Your Privacy Rights. In accordance with applicable law, you may have the right to:

- **Access to and Portability of Your Personal Information**, including: (i) confirming whether we are processing your personal information; (ii) obtaining access to or a copy of your personal information; and (iii) receiving an electronic copy of personal information that you have provided to us, or asking us to send that information to another company in a structured, commonly used, and machine readable format (also known as the “right of data portability”);
- **Request Correction** of your personal information where it is inaccurate or incomplete. In some cases, we may provide self-service tools that enable you to update your personal information;
- **Request Deletion** of your personal information;
- **Request Restriction of or Object to** our processing of your personal information; and
- **Withdraw your Consent** to our processing of your personal information. Please note that your withdrawal will only take effect for future processing, and will not affect the lawfulness of processing before the withdrawal.

6. SECURITY OF YOUR INFORMATION

We take steps to ensure that your information is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Notice. Unfortunately, no system is 100% secure, and we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you provide to us. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, we do not accept liability for unauthorized access, use, disclosure, or loss of personal information.

By using our Turnkey Services or providing personal information to us, you agree that we may communicate with you electronically regarding security, privacy, and administrative issues relating to your use of our Turnkey Services. If we learn of a security system’s breach, we may attempt to notify you electronically by posting a notice on our Turnkey Services, by mail, or by sending an email to you.

7. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

All information processed by us may be transferred, processed, and stored anywhere in the world, including, but not limited to, the United States or other countries, which may have data protection laws that are different from the laws where you live. We endeavor to safeguard your information consistent with the requirements of applicable laws.

If we transfer personal information which originates in the European Economic Area, Switzerland, and/or the United Kingdom to a country that has not been found to provide an adequate level of

protection under applicable data protection laws, one of the safeguards we may use to support such transfer is the [EU Standard Contractual Clauses](#).

8. RETENTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We store the personal information we collect as described in this Privacy Notice for as long as you use our Turnkey Services, or as necessary to fulfill the purpose(s) for which it was collected, provide our Turnkey Services, resolve disputes, establish legal defenses, conduct audits, pursue legitimate business purposes, enforce our agreements, and comply with applicable laws.

9. SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

Beginning January 1, 2020, the California Consumer Privacy Act (“**CCPA**”) gives California residents certain rights with respect to the processing of personal data (known as “personal information” under the CCPA).

This supplement provides additional privacy disclosures and details additional rights and should be read in conjunction with our Privacy Policy.

Collection of Information

Section 2 of our Privacy Policy sets forth the categories of personal information that we collect and process about you, a description of each category, and the sources from which we obtain each category. Section 3 describes how we use your personal information, and Section 4 describes our sharing practices.

Your Rights

Right to Know

Under the CCPA, you have a right to request information about our collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information over the prior 12 months, and request that we provide you with the following information:

- Categories of and specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you.
- Categories of sources from which we collect personal information.
- Purposes for collecting personal information.
- Categories of third parties with whom we share personal information.
- Categories of personal information disclosed about you for a business purpose.
- If applicable, categories of personal information sold about you and the categories of third parties to which the personal information was sold, by category or categories of personal information for each third party to which the personal information was sold.

Right to Delete

You also have a right to request that we delete personal information, subject to certain limitations under applicable law.

Right to Opt-out From Sale

You may request to opt-out of any “sale” of your personal information that may take place. We do not rent or sell personal information and take care to not enter into any data sharing arrangements that could constitute a “sale” under the CCPA.

Non-discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your rights under the CCPA.

10. CHILDREN'S INFORMATION

The Turnkey Services are not directed to children under 16 (or other age as required by local law), and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

If you are a parent or guardian and believe your child has uploaded personal information to our site without your consent, you may contact us as described in "[Contact Us](#)" below. If we become aware that a child has provided us with personal information in violation of applicable law, we will delete any personal information we have collected, unless we have a legal obligation to keep it, and terminate the child's account, if applicable.

11. OTHER PROVISIONS

Third-Party Websites/Applications. The Turnkey Services may contain links to other websites/applications and other websites/applications may reference or link to our Turnkey Services. These third-party services are not controlled by us. We encourage our users to read the privacy policies of each website and application with which they interact. We do not endorse, screen, or approve, and are not responsible for, the privacy practices or content of such other websites or applications. Providing personal information to third-party websites or applications is at your own risk.

Supervisory Authority. If your personal information is subject to the applicable data protection laws of the European Economic Area, Switzerland, or the United Kingdom, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority if you believe our processing of your personal information violates applicable law.
